Brief Description of Project:

Rural county roads are becoming overgrown with brush, trees, and noxious weeds. Overgrown vegetation along right-of-ways often creates hazardous conditions by obstructing motorist's vision, which is creating unsafe transportation systems in Shoshone County. The overgrown vegetation also creates camouflage for wildlife. Large game stepping out of the overgrown vegetation onto roads can be deadly for both unsuspecting motorists and wildlife.

This request is for the purchase of herbicide to control brush and noxious weeds within right-of-ways.
